

On-site Training Disclaimer and Indemnity Terms

The ABMMA takes reasonable care when scheduling its training courses. However, attendance on site at training involves certain inherent risks. Attendance at this course requires you to indemnify the ABMMA and its representatives against these risks by signing this waiver. To the extent possible at law, you agree to unconditionally and irrevocably indemnify the ABMMA and its representatives against any and all claims, liabilities, damages and losses you might incur as a consequence of attending this course.

You acknowledge that attendance at this course is voluntary and that at the time of signing this document you are in good health with no physical or mental condition that would create a risk to health and safety by attending this course.

The ABMMA does not manufacture the machines utilised during training. You indemnify ABMMA and its representatives against any loss or damage associated with your machine during training including a faulty machine or misuse of the machine against either the manufacturer guidelines or ABMMA instruction.

The ABMMA does not own the premises where training is held. The ABMMA takes reasonable steps to ensure the premises are safe and satisfactory to host training. However, the ABMMA makes no guarantee that the premises are free of risk. You indemnify the ABMMA and its representatives from any claim for occupier liability and any loss or damage incurred as a consequence of attending the premises, including, but not limited to unsafe premises, inadequate lighting, faulty elevators, slippery stairs or walkways.

Other than treatment tables and trollies, the ABMMA does not own or supply the facilities and equipment utilised at training. This is hired by the facility owner. The ABMMA takes reasonable steps to ensure the equipment is safe and satisfactory to host training. However, the ABMMA makes no guarantee that the equipment is free of risk. You agree to indemnify the ABMMA and its representatives from any claim for occupier liability and any loss or damaged incurred as a consequence of attending the premises, including, but not limited to falling light fixtures, breaking chairs and/or collapsing tables.

If you are more comfortable bringing your own equipment, including a treatment table, you are welcomed and encouraged to do so. The ABMMA and its representatives disclaim liability for any injury, accident or undesirable effect that may occur due to any equipment another party, such as a fellow participant, may bring to this training course. This is to include, but is not limited to, a treatment table that may be shared or be the cause of an accident or injury.

The ABMMA and its representatives disclaim liability for any inappropriate behaviour or actions by any persons encountered at the course. This includes, but is not limited to, hotel or meeting-site staff, other participants, teaching assistants and ABMMA staff. If you encounter any inappropriate behaviour, please notify the instructor or facilitator immediately. If this is not possible, please contact the ABMMA office directly.
